

CITY OF CANNON FALLS JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Pool-Swim Instructor/Lifeguard
DEPARTMENT: Parks
REPORTS TO: Pool Manager
FLSA STATUS: Non-exempt
SALARY RANGE: Non-Permanent Part Time

POSITION OBJECTIVE

The lifeguards/swim instructors are primarily responsible for protecting the patrons using the swimming pool.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Guards the patrons using the swimming pool.
- Teaches swimming lessons, which includes swimming strokes and techniques.
- Clean pool, pool area, locker rooms and guard house.
- Anything else asked by management.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Working knowledge of the swimming pool pumps, waterpark pumps and the testing equipment. The lifeguards/swim instructors must notify the manager or head lifeguard to contact the Public Works Department if assistance is needed.
- The lifeguards/swim instructors will need to be trained in using emergency equipment such as the oxygen tank and defibrillator.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

By law, applicants must be 15 years of age by June 1 of the swimming season. The lifeguards/swim instructors need to be trained in the Jeff Ellis National Pools and Waterparks Program. Previous swimming courses and junior lifesaving is preferred. Must be able to protect the patrons using the swimming pool. Must attain Ellis Assoc. licensure within five days of completion of training by City.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

EXTENT OF SUPERVISION OR GUIDANCE PROVIDED

Works under the guidance and supervision of the Pool Manager.
